4. Class Entry Numbers

- A. A minimum of five competitors are required for each class for all places to be awarded.
- B. If Less than five competitors only 1st place will be awarded.
- C. The Maximum number of competitors per class is 64.

5. Awards

All classes and awards are subject to achieving the minimum required number of competitors and will be awarded as per below.

- 1st Place Medal
- 2nd Place Silver Medal
- 3rd Place Bronze Medal

2 Gun Aggregate (Light Rifle and Heavy Rifle)

- 1st Place Trophy
- 2nd Place Silver Medal
- 3rd Place Bronze Medal

3 Gun Aggregate (Sporter, Light Rifle, Heavy Rifle)

- 1st Place Trophy
- 2nd Place Silver Medal
- 3rd Place Bronze Medal

5 Gun Aggregate (Air Rifle (Light and Heavy), Unlimited Air Rifle, Sporter, Light Rifle and Heavy Rifle)

- 1st Place Trophy
- 2nd Place Silver Medal
- 3rd Place Bronze Medal

6. Event Entry

- A. Event entries are online via the online entry form or the attached form prior to the 23rd of April.

- C. Competitors sharing equipment will be required to indicate what equipment is being shared. With the shared items to be listed on **both competitors' forms**, those without this clearly stated will be assumed to be not sharing said equipment.
- D. Late entries may be accepted subject to bay availability, it is highly recommended that you nominate to reserve your place.

8. Event Schedule

- Practice for all classes is available Friday the 25th from 5pm to 7pm.
- All competitors who intend to practice are required to sign on prior to commencing practice.
- Sign on for competitors will close 30 minutes prior to commencement of your first class of the event. That is, you only need to sign on once and is no requirement to attend until the event you are competing in is scheduled.
- Range wind flag set up is from 7:00 am to 8:10 am and from 12:15 to 12:45 on the 25th April on all days of competition.
- Range is closed at 8:10 am each day, no one forward of line from the announcement of range closed.

10. Course Of Fire

- All classes will be allowed 10 minutes set up time prior to the start of their detail.

B. The number of shots and target as per the below table.

Class	Distance	COF
Air Rifle	25m	3 x 25 Shots
Un-limited Air	50m	3 x 25 Shots
Sporter	50m	3 x 25 Shots
Light Rifle	50m	3 x 25 Shots
Heavy Rifle	50m	3 x 25 Shots

- C. All classes have unlimited sighters within time allowed.
D. All details are timed, and duration is 20 minutes.

11. Bay Allocation

- A. Allocation of bays will occur at the close of entries with the bay allocation draw to be supplied to all competitors in the final instructions. Final instructions will be supplied on the Wednesday evening 17th April.
B. Bay rotation will occur for competitors competing in multiple classes, allocated bays are fixed by the class you are competing in for the duration of course of fire.

12. Targets

- A. Competitors will be issued all required targets prior to commencement of that classes course of fire.
B. Targets will be clearly marked with your Competitor ID, Detail Number and Bay Number to assist with cross checking and scoring.
C. Is the competitor's responsibility to install their target down range in preparation for the competitor's relevant detail when called upon by the range officer to do so.
D. Competitors will be afforded time at the completion of their detail to view targets down range when asked to do so by range officer.
E. All completed targets will be removed and taken into the score room by the appointed official. Competitors are not permitted to handle any target they may only be viewed.
F. Photography of targets down range is permitted for competitors records only.

13. Scoring

- A. The score team will score all targets in a timely manner and record scores into the score system.
B. A cross check will be conducted to ensure that the results are correct.
C. Scored targets will then be available for review on the wailing wall, competitors are reminded touching of posted targets is not permitted.
D. All requests for review of a posted score are as per WBRF rules.

14. Protests

- A. All protest are to be in writing on the appropriate form available on request.
B. A protest fee of \$35 applies to lodge every protest and is payable at time of lodgement. Protests will not be accepted without payment.

15. General Rules

- A. All competitors are reminded that the WASRA range safety rules apply in addition to WBRF Rules. With all rifles always requiring a breech flag in chamber when not in use on the firing line as instructed by the range officer.

- B. The movement of rifles to and from the firing line is to be high port arms (that is muzzle to sky) at all times.
- C. No competitors on the firing line until instructed by the range officer.
- D. Any wind flags set up by competitor, are also available to other competitors during course of the event. The event organiser accepts no responsibility for any damage to your down range equipment during course of the event.
- E. All competitors are asked to assist in smooth running of the event by clearing their bay promptly at end of each detail when instructed by range officer. This will assist in completion of scheduled events in a timely manner.

16. Additional Information

- A. Due to Western Australia firearm laws all interstate competitors will need to hold a permit to carry and use their firearms at this competition. For more details or to check local requirements for possession of firearms in West Australia go to:
